INSTRUCTORS AND COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Exegesis of Ezekiel, taught by Daniel F. Cates [B.A., M.A.], is an introduction and exegesis of the book of Ezekiel.

History of the English Bible, taught by Keith A. Mosher, Sr. [B.A., M.A., M.Th., D. Min.], traces the history of the English Bible and examines its reliability.

Addiction: Recognition, Response, and Resources, taught by Jerry L. Martin [B.A., M.S. Ph.D., LPC], is designed to train individuals, families, church leaders, and concerned Christian men and women how to recognize and appropriately respond to addictive behavior (drugs, pornography, gambling, food, etc.).

The courses will be of special interest to preachers, elders, Bible class teachers, indeed all Christians.
