REQUIREMENTS:

Each student will be required to pay attention to the instructor, to follow along in the handouts, to do any required reading and assignments outside of class, and to actively participate in class.

Students taking the class toward the M.O.S.T. Certificate must write one three page report on an issue in apologetics--the issue must relate directly to the book of Genesis and subject must be approved by the teacher. Students taking the class for the M.O.S.T. Advanced Diploma must write the a five page report on an issue in apologetics which relates directly to the book of Genesis, a five page sermon on one of the great people of the book of Genesis, and an outline of the book of Genesis at least five pages long. The assignments may be completed in any order. Examples will be given in class. Only students who are auditing are exempt from the outside assignments and final exam; however, they may take part if they desire.
