In talking with brother Cates recently, he desired for me to express to all of our wonderful alumni and beloved friends his deepest gratitude for all the well-wishes, cards, calls, emails, and especially prayers on his behalf.

Around four months ago, brother Cates went through a number of examinations and tests and was approved for a special clinical trial at the West Clinic. They have been doing work on his cells and infusing them back into his body so that his immune system would react more positively, and that the chemo would have better effect. He is one of two to have this procedure. The doctors say it is on the “cutting edge” in the medical field.

We are happy to report that this procedure appears to have produced a favorable result. Brother Cates received his first chemo treatment in January. The results have been very positive. In fact, the word the oncologist used was, “Awesome!” He will be taking these chemo treatments once a month for awhile. We are glad to say that Brother Cates is feeling much better. Don Finney (1976), lost his wife Ann, on 12-31-10.

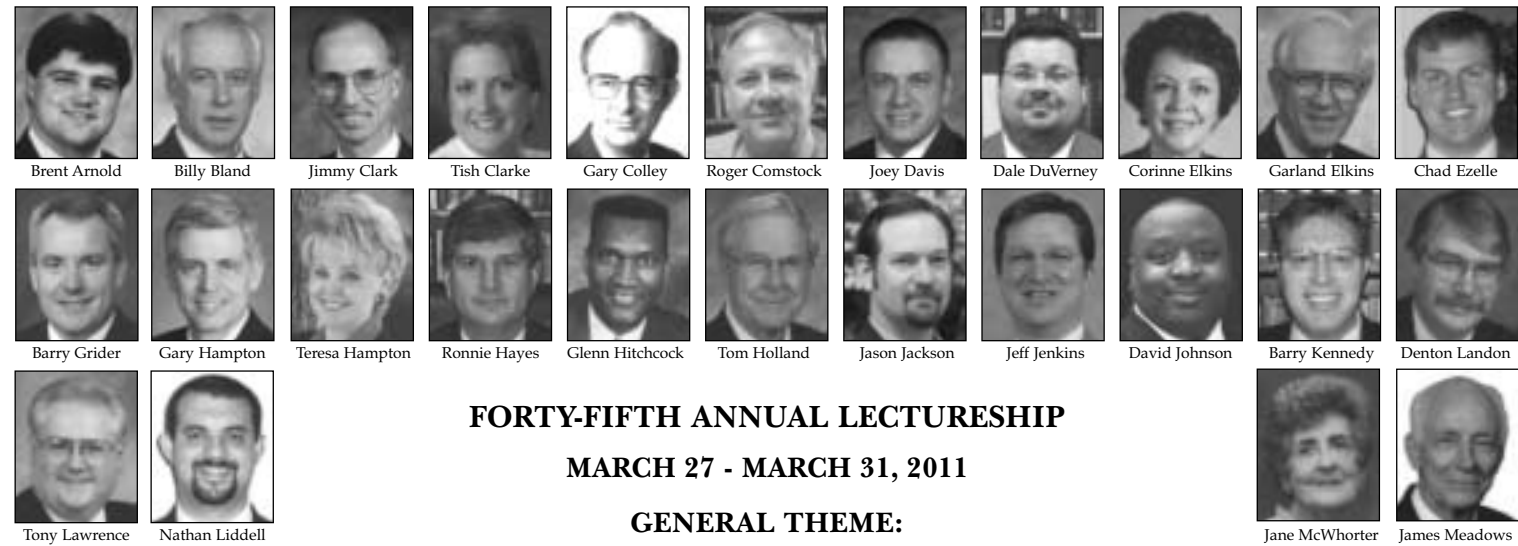

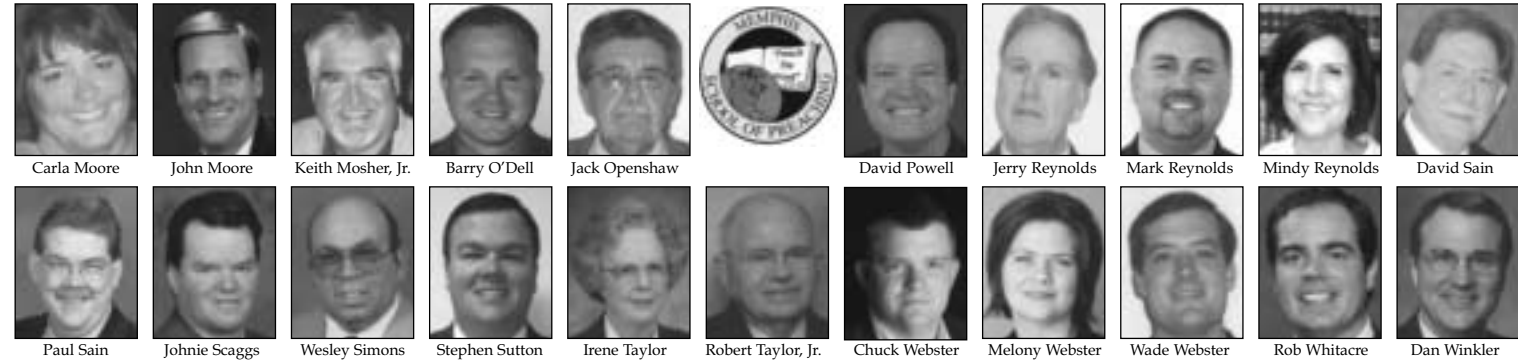
