

PREMILLENNIALISM MOST CLASS — ASSIGNMENTS (ALL TRACKS)

1) Audit Track Assignment

Goal: Attend, listen, and grow in clarity on biblical eschatology and the kingdom.

Requirements

- Attend the sessions (as many as possible).
- Bring a Bible (NKJV preferred for class alignment).
- Optional: take notes and participate in discussion when invited.

No written work required.

Auditors are welcome to ask questions and join discussions, but there are no grades, papers, or deadlines.

2) Certificate Track Paper (5 pages) — The Antichrist: A Biblical Case Review

Assignment

Write a 5-page paper (double-spaced) proving from Scripture that the Bible's "antichrist" language refers to first-century/ongoing doctrinal opposition—not a single end-times political ruler still awaiting arrival.

Required Texts to Use (minimum)

You must interact meaningfully with these passages:

- 1 John 2:18–27
- 1 John 4:1–6
- 2 John 7–11

You must also use at least three of the following:

- John 1:1–3; 1:14; 1:18
- 2 John 9
- Colossians 2:8–10
- 2 Thessalonians 2:1–12 (distinguish "antichrist" from "man of sin/lawlessness")
- Matthew 24:4–5, 11, 23–24 (false christs/false prophets)
- Acts 20:28–31 (wolves; doctrinal danger)

Required Structure (use these headings)

1. Introduction (½ page)

State the thesis clearly.

2. Define "Antichrist" Biblically (1 page)

Explain what John means by the term, including the plural "many antichrists."

3. Textual Proof from John's Epistles (2 pages)

Show why John's markers ("now," "already," present deceivers) rule out a purely futuristic view.

4. Common Premillennial Claims Answered (1 page)

Address at least two common claims (e.g., "Antichrist = Revelation beast," "Antichrist = man of sin").

5. Conclusion (½ page)

Summarize the argument and explain why the issue matters doctrinally.

Format Requirements

- 5 full pages (not counting title/works cited)
- Double-spaced, 12 pt font, 1-inch margins
- Include a simple Works Cited (Bible + any sources used)

Grading (100 pts)

- Thesis & clarity (15)
- Exegesis of 1–2 John passages (35)
- Handling of opposing arguments (20)
- Use of Scripture and logical flow (20)
- Style/format (10)

3) Advanced Certificate Track Paper (12 pages)

Paper Topic

“Ten Reasons Premillennialism Is Wrong: Define and Defeat”

Purpose

Write a 12-page paper that lists 10 distinct premillennial claims, then defines each claim fairly and defeats it with Scripture in context.

Required: 10-Point Framework (use these unless you already have your own list)

1. The Kingdom Is Still Future
2. The Church Is a Parenthesis/Afterthought
3. Christ Is Not Reigning Now (Lordship Deferred)
4. Israel and the Church Are Two Separate Peoples with Separate Promises
5. A Future Earthly Throne of David in Jerusalem Is Necessary
6. The Rapture as a Separate Coming of Christ
7. Multiple Resurrections Separated by 1,000 Years
8. A Future 7-Year Tribulation as Daniel’s 70th Week (Prophetic Clock

Paused)

9. Restoration of OT Worship (Temple/Sacrifices/Priesthood)
10. Revelation 20 Requires a Literal 1,000-Year Earthly Reign

Required Scripture Sets (minimum)

Use at least one core text from each cluster:

Kingdom Now

- Daniel 2:44
- Mark 1:14–15
- Mark 9:1
- Colossians 1:13
- Revelation 1:9

One Coming / One Consummation

- 1 Corinthians 15:23–26
- John 5:28–29
- Acts 24:15
- 2 Timothy 4:1

Rapture Claims Tested

- 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18
- 2 Thessalonians 2:8
- 2 Peter 3:10–12

Daniel 9 / Seventy Weeks

- Daniel 9:24–27 (address the “gap” claim)
- Add at least one confirming NT tie-in text (e.g., Hebrews 9:26–28 or

Matthew 26:28)

OT System Ended

- Colossians 2:14
- Hebrews 7:12
- Hebrews 8:13
- Hebrews 10:10–14

Revelation 20

- Revelation 20:1–15
- Revelation 1:1–3 (symbolic/time-near controls)
- Revelation 22:18–19 (warning about adding)

Required Method for Each of the 10 Reasons (repeat this pattern 10 times)

- Claim Stated (Premillennial Position)
- Why the Claim Appeals to People (brief)
- Define (key terms + what they mean in the claim)
- Defeat (main texts, context, argument)
- Consequences of the Error (what it does to the gospel/kingdom/church)

Format Requirements

- 12 full pages (not counting title/works cited)
- Double-spaced, 12 pt, 1-inch margins
- Works Cited (Bible + sources used)

Grading (100 pts)

- Clear definition and fairness to opposing view (20)
- Strength of scriptural refutation and context use (40)
- Logical organization and transitions (20)
- Theological implications handled correctly (10)
- Style/format (10)
