CONCERNING THE MEMPHIS SCHOOL OF PREACHING'S GRADUATE PROGRAM

When I first started full-time teaching at the Memphis School of Preaching, in 1984, there existed a "Third-year Program." The educational concept of those classes was to advance the knowledge of those who had attended a two-year preaching school who would receive a "graduate certificate," and to give a "certificate" of completion to those who attended without the preaching-school background. Auditing of those classes was also allowed.

When I attained the Doctor of Ministry from Harding Graduate School of Religion in 1989, I along with Doctor Curtis A. Cates, was invited to be on the adjunct faculty of Alabama School of Religion (now Amridge University). Brother Cates then decided that we could offer a bachelor's degree and master's degree in our third-year program, if the students did their work through Alabama School of Religion. Eventually, the offering of such degrees ceased to be given in the third-year program, and students were offered tuition breaks at Amridge University. I am not on their adjunct faculty any longer, but Amridge still gives a huge break in tuition for preachers and preaching students.

The third-year program at Memphis School of Preaching is now known as the "MOST" program, and advanced studies are still being done, and all the MOST classes are archived. It was known, however, that certain areas of study were not covered in the two-year program, which has not changed in its daily classes since its inception in 1966, except for a few summer additions, including logic and archaeology. A Missions Program was introduced, but the need for apologetics, ethics, and advanced professional studies still existed. Brother Bobby Liddell and brother B. J. Clarke put together a graduate program to cover the subjects not offered in the two-year program, nor in the MOST studies. The graduate program is much needed and has already attracted five full-time students, two of whom are graduates of another preaching school.

My prayer is that those who desire to be elders will also be attracted to furthering their studies. Preachers are being trained to the nth degree, but there is no Memphis School of Eldering, except that the MOST program can get one ready for the graduate studies. I am grateful to know that the faculty here saw the "holes" in the curriculum of the two-year program, and is now offering great advanced studies. There have been those who questioned a "graduate" program in a Bible school, for reasons known only to them. But, as one who holds advanced degrees, I am sure that more study is needed in my life at eighty-six years of age, and the Graduate Program at Memphis School of Preaching is a glorious work. I would invite all who are qualified to take advantage of such studies.
